With your help, I feel we have made many improvements, which will benefit everyone who visits the cemetery.



This fall we put 56 additional ton of gravel on the roads and some of the ditches were cleaned out again. Throughout the summer months we paid for mowing the entrance to the cemetery. As I mentioned in my letter of January 21, 2006, we now have depleted the checking account. I will be notifying the WV Secretary of State and the Internal Revenue Service that this non-profit fund has ceased.
